# The Oxford Analytica Conference: Global Horizons 2023

### **Terms & Conditions**

These Terms & Conditions are between Oxford Analytica Ltd. ("Oxford Analytica") and the person who registers for attendance ("You") at The Oxford Analytica Conference: Global Horizons 2023 to be held in Oxford from 5 - 7 September 2023 ("Conference").

All references to a date or deadline, mentioned in these terms and on other conference documents refer to BST (during summer months) and GMT (during winter months).

# **Confirmation of bookings**

- All registrations are subject to availability and acceptance by Oxford Analytica. A confirmation email confirming registration will be sent once the application has been accepted. By registering for the Conference, you are agreeing to comply with these terms and conditions.
- Upon Oxford Analytica's email confirmation to You of its acceptance of your registration for a place at the Conference there shall be a legally binding contract between Oxford Analytica and You to which these terms and conditions apply.
- Oxford Analytica reserves the right to refuse to accept any booking in its absolute discretion.

### **Payment**

- Fees for the Conference are as follows:
  - o Full attendee place = £2,800
- The fees include:
  - o The full conference includes a specially-commissioned briefing document, 2.5 day conference programme, three nights' accommodation at Christ Church, all meals, black-tie dinner in Oxford and 2 months access to the Oxford Analytica Daily Brief.
- All fees stated are full price fees
- Discounts for clients and early bird prices are available as advertised
- \_ If You have paid by credit or debit card, Oxford Analytica shall provide a receipt for payment of the deliverables. Otherwise Oxford Analytica shall invoice the customer of the deliverables at any time after the placement of the registration
- If the event date is 4 weeks or less, payment by invoice is no longer accepted and payment via credit/debit card only
- Invoices must be paid in full, without deduction, within 14 days of the date of each invoice and to the bank account nominated by Oxford Analytica
- Where payment is not made, Oxford Analytica can charge interest at 5% and interest shall accrue on a daily basis and apply from the due date of payment until the actual payment in full

- Payment must be made in GBP only, by credit, debit or bank transfer
- All bank transactions must include the registration number and the attendees full name as a reference
- All fees are subject to VAT at 20%
- \_ The conference is residential and we regret there can be no fee reduction for those wishing to stay outside Christ Church

### Cancellations by You

- \_ All cancellation requests must be sent to <a href="mailto:conference@oxford-analytica.com">conference@oxford-analytica.com</a>. Cancellations will be subject to the charges outlined below:
  - Cancellations received in writing on or before July 6 2023 will incur an administrative fee of 5% of the ticket price paid
  - o Cancellations received after July 6 2023 and before July 24 2023 will will be refunded 50% of the price paid
  - o Cancellations received after August 5 2023 will be non-refundable
- Appropriate attendee substitutions can be made at any time
- Refunds will be processed in the following ways:
  - o Payment via credit or debit cards the same card will be refunded, not including the transaction fee
  - o For all other payments, a bank transfer will be made to the payee nominated account and all bank charges will be directly deducted from the refund

## Modification of the program advertised

Oxford Analytica reserves the right to modify the program. No refunds can be granted in case of cancellation of speakers, lack of space in the conference room or any incidents during the Conference which are beyond the control of Oxford Analytica

#### Failure to attend

No refunds will be provided on failure to attend and attendees will be subject to payment in full of the original booking fee

#### Visa

- It is Your responsibility to make sure your visa is valid and up to date when entering the United Kingdom
- If You require an entry visa you must allow sufficient time for the application procedure. Oxford Analytica cannot intervene on your behalf in case of a rejection or to speed up the procedure

# **Cancellations or postponements by Oxford Analytica**

Oxford Analytica may in exceptional circumstances need to postpone or cancel the Conference and we will notify You as soon as reasonably practical of any such postponement or cancellation. If the Conference is postponed and you cannot attend the rescheduled date, we will refund any Fees you have paid less a 10% administration fee. You agree that Oxford Analytica's liability to You will be limited to the amount of the Fees You have paid and Oxford Analytica will not be liable to You for any expenditure, damage or loss, such as but not limited to transportation costs, accommodation costs, costs for additional orders, financial losses etc, incurred by You as a result of the cancellation or postponement.

# **Termination**

- Oxford Analytica may terminate the contract at any time by giving notice in writing to the customer if:
  - You commit a material breach of the contract
  - o You fail to pay any amount due under the contract on the due date and such amount remains unpaid within 30 days after Oxford Analytica has given notification that the payment is overdue
  - Any consent, licence or authorisation held by You is revoked or modified such that You are no longer able to comply with its obligations under the contract or receive any benefit to which it is entitled
- Oxford Analytica may terminate the contract at any time by giving notice if:
  - o You stop carrying out significant part of its business, or indicates in any way that it intends to do so
  - o You are unable to pay its debts
  - o Becomes the subject of a company voluntary arrangement under insolvency
  - o If You become aware that any event has occurred which may entitle Oxford Analytica to terminate the contract, You shall immediately notify Oxford Analytica in writing at <a href="mailto:conference@oxford-analytica.com">conference@oxford-analytica.com</a>

## Governing law

The contract and any dispute or claim arising out of, or in connection with its subject matter or formation shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England or Wales

### **Jurisdiction**

The parties irrevocably agree that the courts of England and Wales shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim arising out of, or in connection with, the Contract, its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims)
